## Funding Competition – Deadline 15 April 2022

We invite applications for research grants to understand and support unarmed civilian protection and self-protection amidst violent conflict.

We hope to fund about 15 - 20 research projects of GBP £20,000 - £100,000.

Projects have to be led by organisations from the UK or from Low and Middle Income Countries (LMICs). More details are available on our <u>website</u>.
